

Teachable machine

The solution does not require any programming skills. It is very simple and intuitive. It is a good introduction to the concepts of bias and machine learning.

To create a model, the user must

1. obtain a correctly labelled data set
2. train the model
3. test their model with data not provided.

We recommend the website <https://thispersondoesnotexist.com/> to get images for your models. The site generates images by an AI at each refresh. Impressive, isn't it?


